

VOLUNTEER & WORK OPPORTUNITIES AT ART ADVENTURES

VOLUNTEERS

This is the most fun job you will ever have! Most students try to schedule volunteering for the class before or after their art class. A volunteer will do all sorts of odd jobs (like cleaning paint brushes, handing out paper, organizing fun boards, stacking construction paper, and even working with students from time to time. Volunteers may “skip” work days at any time. This way, students can “taste” what it is like to hold a job without the strict obligations that often accompany it. So, for heavy homework days, exam time, sick days, family occasions, etc, a volunteer may simply leave a message on the studio phone that they will not be coming in. Advance notice is appreciated, but not necessary. There may be more than one volunteer in a class at a time. Students must be in the 8th grade or older to be a volunteer.

AIDES

An aide is a paid position. After volunteering for 40 hours, an aide is eligible to earn minimum wage. Students must be in the 9th grade or older and have a valid work permit to be an aide. Aides will have similar duties as a volunteer with more opportunities to work with students. An aide will help show younger students how to mix simple colors (like black and white to make gray), how to get foil/water/sock, how to clean up, or add simple parts to their drawings like an ear or grass. How cool to be at art and get paid!!

It is not required, but I do strongly request that aides give advance notice for absences and try to find a replacement for their shift. Upon request, a phone list will be provided for you. I find this helps ease an aide into what it is like to hold a “real job”. Ordinarily, there is only one aide in a class at a time. Aide placements are based on seniority and their performance as a volunteer.
