Summer camps are available for students ages 4 and up. We offer Drawing & Painting, Clay, Paper Mache, Printmaking, Art Fun, Cartooning, Photography and more! Designed for summer fun, all skill levels are welcome.

Students rising to the first grade or older can join any camp [except the Pre-K/K camp, photography classes and some Art Excursions].

Since we teach one to one, we are able to combine all ages in our summer camps. Working in a relaxed but guided setting, students choose their own subject matter and work at their own pace. Every piece of art is different so the classroom is void of competition. We strive to build the self-confidence of each student. We treat each student like members of our own family. SUMMER 2010 CAMP DESCRIPTIONS

All students at Art Adventures are taught on a one-to-one basis at their skill level, so mixed ages are welcome in most of our classes.

You will find a suggested age range listed with each class description, however exceptions are made in some cases. Since each class is different, you could sign up for three Draw & Paint classes throughout the summer and take home a different picture each time!

Photography meets for two hours each day, while all other

Classes meet Monday-Thursday for one hour each day.

DRAW & PAINT: Students will draw or paint a landscape, animal, cartoon or picture of their choice! All skill levels are welcome. All supplies are included. This class is suitable for children rising to kindergarten and older. \$59.

3-D ART: Students will choose from one of the following projects: Plaster Casting (make a mold of their face or hand), Paper Mache or Mask Making (make a life size animal or wild mask)! Sign up for this class more than once and you could try them all! All supplies are included. This class is suitable for children in kindergarten and older. \$69.

MIXED MEDIA: Students will use crazy colors, abstract design and collage to create their own masterpieces. Emphasis will be on manipulating paint in new ways (such as layering and scraping) using metallic and textured paints, and the use of speciality brushes (like fan, liner, mop brush and pallet knife). All supplies are included. This class is suitable for children in kindergarten and older. \$59.

JEWELRY: Students will create beautiful pendants and exotic jewelry for themselves to wear or to give as gifts. No two pieces are alike. This class is suitable for children in kindergarten and older. All supplies are included. \$73.

ADVANCED DRAWING: This is an advanced class intended to emphasize the improvement of drawing skills while learning new tips and tricks. The focus of this class will be on enhancing drawing skills with the utilization of charcoal, conte crayons, oil sticks, and pen & ink. Drawings will be from life and still objects. This is a great class for portfolio development! This class is suitable for students rising to the sixth grade and older. \$59.

CLAY: Students will use hand building techniques to create their own ceramic sculpture! All projects are completely unique. Fee includes clay and a rainbow of glaze options. This class is suitable for children in kindergarten and older. \$69.

FASHION DESIGN: Students will create beach fashions, embellish jean items and design bedroom accessories like picture frames or light switch plates. *Please bring one article of denim apparel to transform into your own unique fashion! Some ideas include: a jean jacket, denim purse, or jean shorts. This class is suitable for children in kindergarten and older. \$73.

ART FUN: Students will explore linoleum printing, tie dying and more! Please bring two items from the following list to manipulate: T-shirt, bandana, or pillowcase. All items must be 100% cotton, solid white and pre-washed. This class is suitable for children in kindergarten and older. (Students rising to the sixth grade and older will have the option to try silk screen printing too!) \$73

CARTOONING & ILLUSTRATION: Students will create an original super hero or other cartoon character, and then design a cartoon strip based on their character. This class is suitable for children in kindergarten and older. All supplies are included. \$59.

RECYCLED FASHIONS: NEW! Students will create their own fashions by combining recycled materials like bottle caps and old cd's with belts, bags and hats! Please bring an old hat, neck tie, shoulder bag or belt to manipulate. This class is suitable for students rising to the sixth grade and older. \$69.

PRE-K: Projects include everything from drawing & painting, clay and more! Students must be at least four years old. \$65.

PHOTOGRAPHY: Take your own black and white photographs, learn how to develop the film and print the photos in the darkroom. Students will use the tricks and techniques of a professional portrait photographer. Students will explore both pinhole and 35mm photography. *Please bring a 35 mm film camera: either an automatic point & shoot or SLR will do fine, nothing fancy needed! (No digital or disposable cameras please) The camera should be empty of film and have a fresh battery. If possible, please bring the camera's manual too. Fee includes chemicals, film and photographic paper. This class meets for two hours each day, Monday-Thursday. This class is suitable for students in the sixth grade and older. \$95.

ART EXCURSIONS

Art supplies, camera and lunch are included. Directions and specific instructions regarding dress and weather will be provided upon registration. Participants must know how to swim.

Tubing/Tree Climbing

August 6th 8:30am-1:30pm Ages 8+ \$95

Upon arrival, students will be provided water proof cameras to record their trip. A professional photographer will be on site to give photography tips and record the adventure. This Art Adventure has frequent sightings of bald eagles, blue herons and osprey. Students will experience a view of the river and its riparian forest as they climb up into the tree canopy. Simultaneously, students will be recording their experiences and illustrating their day in their sketchbooks. Throughout the day, students will learn how to capture nature and adventure on film and paper, draw caricatures, gestures and enjoy the day! We'll meet at the Pony Pasture parking area and float to the Wetlands. There, we will stretch our legs, have lunch, create art, and transition into Guided Tree Climbing. The stately White Oaks along the river will be outfitted with a safe climbing system including ropes and harnesses. After a fun filled day of art and adventure, participants take a light, guided trail walk back to the Pony Pasture parking area for pick up .

Kayaking

August 4th 8:15am-1:30pm Ages 11+ \$95

We will meet at the Huguenot Flatwater parking lot near the base of the Huguenot Bridge. Upon arrival, students will be provided water proof cameras to record their trip. A professional photographer will be on site to give photography tips and record the adventure. Students will paddle in the flatwater stretch of the river while enjoying the stunning wildlife scenery in one of the most calm and beautiful sections of the James River Park System. We will stop periodically at islands to illustrate the landscape and draw gestures of the people and objects around us. Next, we will have lunch and take a guided tour down the Smith Water Trail with history, nature lessons and more photography. Participants will be picked up at the Huguenot Flatwater parking area.
